

I-630 Construction Progress



Hughes Street Bridge Closed

Work to widen Interstate 630 requires a three-month closure of the Hughes Street overpass. The Hughes Street overpass is closed through late October to remove the structure and reconstruct the bridge. Detours direct Hughes Street traffic to Mississippi Avenue to bypass the closure. Neighborhoods adjacent to the interstate will experience construction noise impacts during daytime and nighttime hours during the work.



What Work Is Happening?

- Temporary barrier wall placement
- Construction work at Hughes Street overpass
- Pavement corrugation removal along the shoulders
- Temporary ramp detour construction
- General clearing

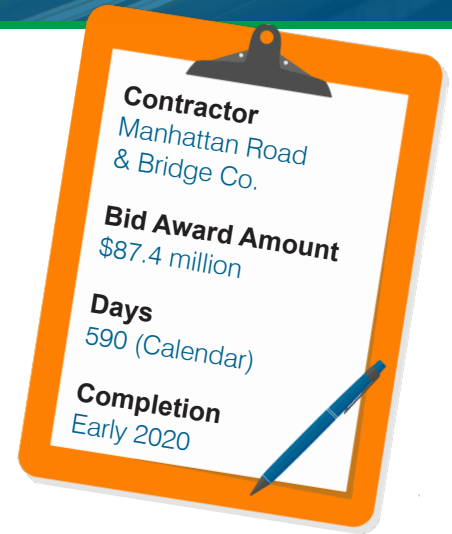
