Upcoming Traffic Shift

Dependent upon weather conditions, a potential traffic shift on Interstate 630 is anticipated mid December to continue with bridge construction.

The traffic shift will occur between John Barrow Road and South Hughes Street. Westbound traffic will shift toward the outside lanes. Eastbound traffic will shift toward the inside lanes.



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- Grading at ramps for John Barrow Road and Baptist Health Drive.
- Grading along I-630 at John Barrow Road and South Hughes Street for mainline lane widening.
- Installing an asphalt base for concrete pavement on I-630 east of John Barrow Road.
- Constructing a retaining wall at the University Avenue on-ramp to I-630 west.
- Constructing retaining walls along I-630 at the South Hughes Street bridge.
- Removing concrete pavement in select areas.
- Drainage work throughout the corridor.
- Drilling and installing noise barrier shafts.
