

I-630 Construction Progress



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- Concrete paving eastbound between John Barrow Road and Rodney Parham Road. Various areas involve prep work for concrete paving.
- Asphalt work westbound between University Avenue and Rodney Parham Road. Also paving various ramps at Rodney Parham Road.
- Grading I-630 main lanes eastbound between South Hughes Street and University Avenue, slopes eastbound between John Barrow Road and Rodney Parham Road, and westbound main lanes between University Avenue and Rodney Parham Road. Grading ramps at Rodney Parham Road and University Avenue.
- Continuing with bridge construction at Rodney Parham Road, including the reinforcing steel, deck, and approach slabs.
- Permanent signal work at John Barrow Road.
- Retaining wall work at South Hughes Street and Rock Creek.



New Ramps at John Barrow Road

Construction crews have moved traffic onto two new I-630 ramps at John Barrow Road (Exit 6B).

- Eastbound exit ramp from I-630 to John Barrow Road
- Westbound entrance ramp from John Barrow Road to I-630
