

I-30 Construction Progress



Construction Set to Begin

The project to widen Interstate 30 in Saline County—the single-largest contract ever awarded by the Arkansas Highway Commission—is scheduled to begin construction Tuesday, May 7.

Johnson Brothers Corporation will begin erosion control on the \$187.3 million project to widen 5.5 miles of I-30 from four to six lanes beginning just west of the interchange with U.S. Highway 70 to Sevier Street in Benton.

Upcoming work also includes installing concrete barrier walls and striping traffic lanes. This work will require overnight lane closures.



Construction Cameras

Twenty traffic construction cameras are being installed within the I-30 construction corridor and will be visible to the public through the iDriveArkansas.com website.

To view once they are live, select the “Traffic” tab (represented by a traffic light icon) and click on “Traffic Cameras.”
