I-30 Construction Progress



Construction Is Underway

The contractor has started placing concrete traffic barriers within the construction zone along Interstate 30, as well as striping for traffic lanes. This work requires overnight lane closures for the next several weeks.

An **AWIS** (automated work zone information system) is now in operation and displays traffic condition information in the workzone. Message signs along the interstate provide traffic information and direct the traveling public to tune their radios to an AM station for a recorded message about operating speeds and other advisory information.

- Continued overnight lane closures
- Concrete traffic barrier installation
- Striping for traffic lanes
- Clearing and grubbing
- Erosion control

Lanes Closed	1. Highway 70 2. Highway 67 3. W. South St. 4. I-30 Frontage Road (east of Saline River)	Traffic reduced to one open lane	Nights, 9:00 pm - 6:00 am
Lanes Closed	I-30 eastbound and westbound	All lanes stopped	On occasion, traffic may be stopped for short intervals, not to exceed 15 minutes, to perform work over interstate lanes
