

I-630 Construction Progress



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- An eastbound I-630 traffic shift onto newly constructed pavement.
- Concrete paving the I-630 westbound on-ramp at University Avenue and multiple Rodney Parham Road ramps, and preparing for concrete paving I-630 eastbound between South Hughes Street and University Avenue.
- Asphalt work in multiple areas within the construction zone.
- Textured finishes on the South Hughes Street bridge and John Barrow Road bridge.
- Grading and concrete work for paved ditches.
- Signalization work at Rodney Parham Road and Mississippi Avenue.
- Continued drainage, excavation, and retaining wall work.



Westbound Traffic Shift Ahead

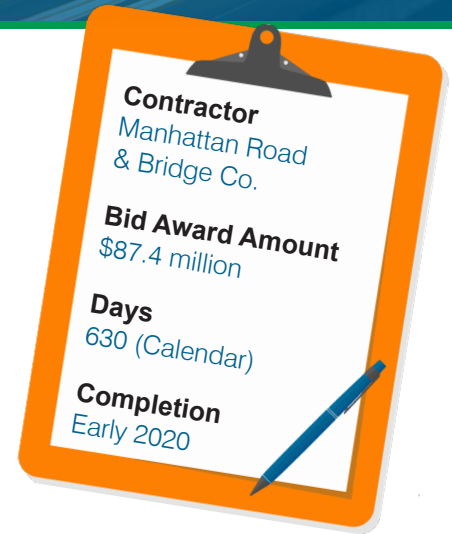
Weather permitting, westbound lanes on I-630 will shift onto newly constructed pavement this July. In addition to the main lane shift, traffic will move onto new pavement at the I-630 westbound on-ramp at University Avenue and the westbound on and off-ramps at Rodney Parham Road.

Inside and middle lanes of westbound traffic will be closed during overnight hours to allow for the shift, and all lanes of traffic may be stopped for 15-minute intervals. The work is anticipated to take place over four nights.
