

I-30 Construction Progress



Road Work Ahead

An increase in construction activity around South Street will begin soon. In addition to the mobilization of cranes, drill rigs, and other equipment, the public is advised to watch for construction vehicles entering and exiting the work site.

Additional concrete barriers will be placed to provide safe work sites within the I-30 median, as well as the space between the frontage roads and interstate lanes.

During bridge and ramp construction at the interchange with Highway 67, the westbound off-ramp at Exit 116 and the frontage roads below the bridge will be reduced to one open lane.
